



Webb Roping Productions Junior World Finals 2022 Qualifier Guidelines



10 & Under Girls & Boys Breakaway

Age as of January 1st, 2022 - Contestants may only qualify one time per age division.

Contestants may compete in more than one age group. **A birth certificate must be submitted with the membership form.**

Required \$100 Membership - Contestants must pay a one-time yearly membership of \$100, **prior to competing in their first qualifying event.**

****NEW FOR 2022** – A \$50 side-pot fee per entry must be paid prior to competing to be eligible to qualify.** – These fees will be 100% paid back at the Junior World Finals as added money for the age division they are paid into at the qualifiers.

How to Qualify: 1st place average winners of each qualifying event, per age division automatically qualify to compete at the Junior World Finals. In the event, that the average winner is not a member or has already qualified, we will drop down to the next member in the average to fill the qualification position.

Points will be assigned per qualifying events throughout the season. (information below)

We plan to take 35 ropers for each age division to the Junior World Finals.

We have the right to adjust this number if situations arise that would require us to do so.

These ropers will be the average winners from each qualifying event, National Champions (NJHRA & NHSRA Breakaway & Tiedown), and the remaining spots will be filled with the top year-end point winners. The National Champions will be placed in the appropriate age division determined by their birth dates. The National Champions must purchase a membership prior to competing at the Junior World Finals. All qualifiers must complete required paperwork & have entry fees paid by the assigned deadline. If a qualifier chooses not to enter the Junior World Finals, a replacement will be chosen.

In the event, a member has already qualified, we will drop down in the year-end points to the next position until all places are filled.

Points will be awarded to members only, as follows:

<u>Average</u>	<u>Rounds</u>	<u>Short-Go</u> (if applicable)
1 st – 9 points	1 st – 6 points	1 st – 3 points
2 nd – 8 points	2 nd – 5 points	2 nd – 2 points
3 rd – 7 points	3 rd – 4 points	3 rd – 1 point
4 th – 6 points	4 th – 3 points	
5 th – 5 points	5 th – 2 points	
6 th – 4 points	6 th – 1 point	

If the qualifying event allows you to enter twice, you will only receive points for the highest total entry. The other points will not count.

Points only awarded to members.

****The #1 Back Number will be awarded to the roper with the most year-end points. For 2022, the #1 Back Number Bonus will be \$2,000!!! Ties will be broken according to roper that competed at most events.**
